



AFFIDAVIT OF ELIGIBILITY AND RELEASE 2019 SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION

I hereby represent that:

I am _____, who has been chosen as a winner of the Fashion Group Foundation of Dallas ("FGF-D") "Fashion Group International of Dallas, Inc., ("FGI-D") 2019 Scholarship Competition ("Contest").

I represent that I am _____ of age and am not a director, officer, and/or employee of the Fashion Group Foundation of Dallas ("FGF-D") or of The Fashion Group International of Dallas, Inc., ("FGI-D"); nor am I an IRS listed dependent of a director, officer or employee of FGF-D and/or FGI-D.

Requesting Usage:

Scholarship recipients will have one year from the date of the Scholarship award, April 12th, 2019 to April 10th, 2020 in which to receive funds. The deadline to apply and submit all tuition statements from colleges/universities and financial institutions to the FGI Dallas office is by April 10th, 2020.

Requests for scholarships are processed by Fashion Group International of Dallas, Inc. and forwarded to the Fashion Group Foundation of Dallas President and Treasurer for its review and approval upon written receipt of statements from colleges and universities or from the Scholarship winner for other educational expenses.

All educational tuition and/or loan bills (promissory note) must be accompanied with a cover letter from the Scholarship winner requesting scholarship award(s). In the cover letter, you must provide the following: your name, student ID number, the name of the educational or financial institution, attention to, educational loan account number, and the address where the check will be mailed. All required documents and a cover letter must be submitted to the FGI of Dallas office by April 10th, 2020 to complete and fully process scholarship awards. *Please send documents by email to fgidallas.office@gmail.com or mail to Fashion Group International of Dallas, 2050 N. Attention: Students who are not continuing their education, have no outstanding school loans or tuition payments, cannot receive a scholarship check directly to them and must forfeit the funds unless used for continuing education.

These scholarship funds may be used for graduate and postgraduate programs, as well as undergraduate degree and vocational programs. The Foundation will pay scholarship funds directly to those educational institutions which maintain a full-time faculty, have a published curriculum, and award a degree or certificate of completion which is recognized by the state in which the institution is located.

Scholarship winners should notify Fashion Group International of Dallas in writing that he/she is enrolling in a specific institution, the name of the financial aid office, attention to the person/department receiving the scholarship award including the student ID number. The scholarship is for tuition, fees, and books ONLY and does not include room and board.

Student Loans

Scholarships may be used for outstanding student loan obligations provided the contestant has satisfactorily completed the coursework for which the loan was obtained. In all cases, requests must include a current bill from the lender showing a current address, a copy of the promissory note showing that the contestant is either the primary or secondary payer of the obligation, and an official transcript showing completion of the coursework.

Usage for Future Expenses and Forfeitures

Scholarships may be used for future educational expenses, provided, however, scholarship recipients must begin use of their scholarships within one (1) year of the date of the award. If a scholarship recipient has not submitted a request to Fashion Group International for their scholarship award dollars during this period, the right to request funds will be forfeited. If a scholarship recipient forfeits any money from their scholarship the award will automatically be forfeited.

Unused Funds

All unused scholarships will revert to Fashion Group Foundation of Dallas for the use of future Scholarship winners according to the above guidelines.

If there is no bill or loan from the educational institution, then the scholarship reverts to the continuing education program. If the student has no continuing education request, the scholarship expires, and the funds remain with the Fashion Group Foundation of Dallas.

- In consideration of the prize awarded to me as a winner of the Contest, I hereby release, FGF-D, FGI-D, their affiliates, directors, officers, trustees, employees, agents and all others associated with the Contest from any and all liability arising out of my participation in the Contest or acceptance or use of any prize, regardless of the legal theory upon which such liability is based.

- If I am the Grand Prize winner of the Paris American Academy Scholarship, I understand that FGF-D will not obtain insurance on my behalf, and I am fully responsible for obtaining my own insurance, should I desire it.
- I must have a valid passport and be available to travel this summer or when the PAA schedule dates are available (**see Appendix on page 5 for detailed information**).

For good and valuable consideration, I give FGF-D, FGI-D and all others associated with the Contest full permission and authority to use my name, picture or other likeness and city and state of residence for purposes of trade, publicity or promotion.

I hereby irrevocably assign to FGF-D and FGI-D any and all rights to my entry in the Contest including, but not limited to, intellectual property rights necessary to publish, produce, use, adapt, edit and/or modify my entry in any way and in any and all media, without limitation and without further compensation.
